Home Institution Sub-committee Summary

- Met 3x this summer in preparation for the home institution interviews
- Developed a rubric for reviewing and scoring the interviews
- Developed a deck that gave institutions more detail on EC-REACH's vision + expectations
- Conducted interviews with teams from each of the four home institution applicants

Northwestern







- Engaged three external reviewers to add their perspective to the process
- Met 2x after the interviews to review the scored rubrics and discuss considerations
- Selected the home for EC-REACH!

Home Institution Selection Process

Path taken to determine a home institution

Summer 2022

- 1. Identify list of all potential institutions
- 2. Open Letter of Inquiry process
- 3. Planning Committee score LOIs on a rubric

- Fall 2022
- 4. Planning Subcommittee host interviews to further assess potential institutions
- 5. Planning Subcommittee score interview with interview rubric
- 6. Planning Subcommittee combine LOI and interview rubric scores to determine best-fit institution



Home Institution Sub-committee Decision

The sub-committee unanimously selected Northwestern as the EC-REACH home with the stipulation that they would work out a partnership with NIU:

- Northwestern was rated highest overall in our second-round interview scoring, as well as in the specific criteria of autonomy and data & resource sharing.
- Northwestern and NIU demonstrated enthusiasm for a partnership with each other in hosting EC-REACH
- Northwestern will draw from NIU's strengths in data resources and community engagement strategies

 The subcommittee also stipulated that Northwestern would prioritize putting the steering committee, alliance partner, and research advisory council bodies in place so that EC-REACH will continue to be advised by a larger group of diverse external stakeholders including community organizations, practitioners, and families

Launch Committee

Launch Committee: November 2022 – June 2023

A Launch Committee is being formed to provide strategic advising to the home institution and launch support staff at Start Early during this critical transition.

Remaining tasks at hand:

- Pursue \$4M seed money to sustain ops for the first three years
- Execute MOU with Northwestern University
 - Support Northwestern's collaboration with NIU
- Transfer administrative and governance functions to Northwestern University:
 - Hire of EC-REACH director
 - Establish and convene three new EC-REACH advisory bodies
 - Create a permanent EC-REACH website
