What is Home Visiting?

Home visiting is a voluntary, proven program where trained home visitors and parents work together to strengthen and support families in a child's first years of life.

HOME VISITING BENEFITS:



Early detection of developmental delays



Strengthened parenting skills



Improved family self-sufficiency



Improved birth outcomes and maternal/infant health



Improved coordination to other community service



Improved school readiness

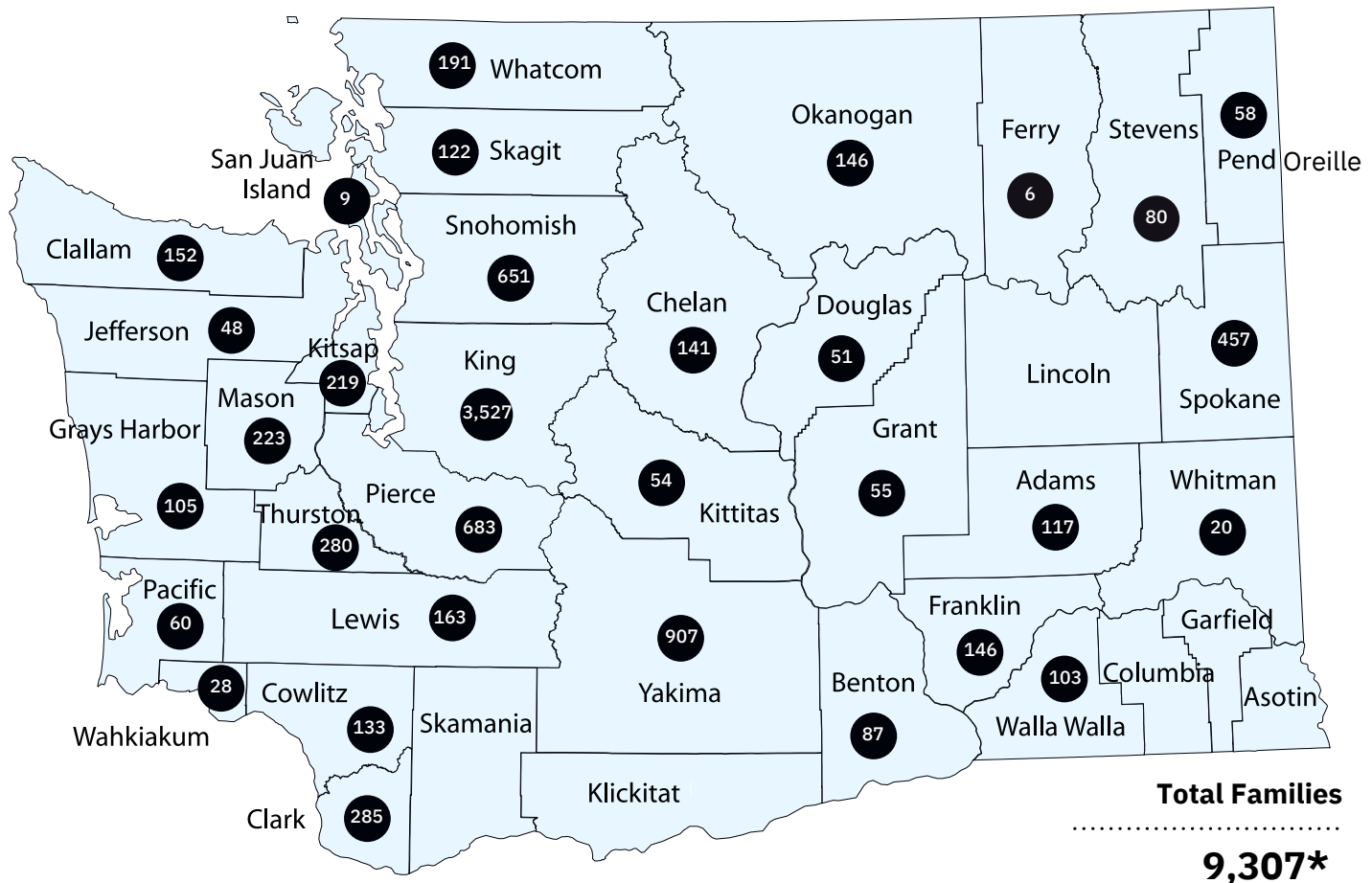

Only a small fraction of eligible families (less than 10%) receive home visiting from federal, state, and local funding sources, which is available for families at or below 200% of the federal poverty level (\$49,720 for a family of three) with a child age 3 or younger.
